

#### Snapchat and social media

We want to inform you about some dangers related to children using social media, especially Snapchat. This app is meant for users aged 13 and older. Unfortunately, many younger children are accessing it, which could expose them to inappropriate images and content and risky situations due to the presence of artificial intelligence in the app.

To help protect your children, here are some simple tips:

- 1. **Talk Openly**: Have regular conversations with your child about what they do online. Encourage them to share anything that worries them about social media.
- 2. **Set Rules**: Make clear rules about which apps they can use and remind them of the age restrictions on different platforms.
- 3. **Discuss Privacy**: Teach your child about privacy settings and help them adjust these settings so they can keep their information safe.
- 4. **Keep an Eye on Usage**: Check which apps your child is using from time to time and talk to them about anything concerning they might encounter online.

By working together, we can help ensure that our children have a safer experience online.



#### **Sunday Gospel Reflection**

6<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time – Luke 6:17-26

Blessed are you

This week in the Sunday Gospel we encounter the Sermon on the Mount and the beautiful teachings of the Beatitudes. In the Beatitudes, Jesus talks about people who are blessed. We might be surprised by some of the people Jesus describes as blessed:

Blessed are you who are poor,

Blessed are you who are hungry,

Blessed are you who weep,

The Beatitudes remind us that, while Jesus loves all people, he is particularly close to us when we poor or hungry or weeping — this could be a spiritual hunger or a time when we feel lonely. At those times Jesus draws us especially close to Him. Jesus also asks us to draw close ourselves to our brothers and sisters who are poor, hungry, lonely, weeping...

What can we do this week to draw close to someone who is sad or lonely or hungry?
