Sunday Gospel Reflection

Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time – Luke 5:1-11

They left everything and followed him.

In this Gospel this Sunday, Jesus calls some of his first disciples.

After stepping into their boat, Jesus tells them to 'put out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch.' They do so, even though they have been fishing all night without success, and are amazed when they catch some many fish that their 'boats began to sink.' In response, the disciples 'left everything and followed' Jesus. In the case of the disciples, many of them did truly leave everything to follow Jesus. We are not likely to be called to such a level of sacrifice, but we do all have things in our lives which get in the way of us following Jesus and that we need to leave behind. This week, take a moment to pause and reflect – what do I need to leave so that I, like those fishermen on the side of the Sea of Galilee, can fully and completely follow Jesus?
