#### **Sunday Gospel Reflection**

Fourth Sunday of Lent – Luke 15:11-32

He was lost, and is found.

This week we encounter the Parable of the Prodigal Son in our Sunday Gospel.

The parable is a beautiful story of forgiveness. Even though the son had greatly upset the father, the father forgave him and rejoiced at his return.

We too can access forgiveness like this. When we truly turn our hearts to God, he never denies us forgiveness – we simply need to be like the son in the parable and 'return home.'

As Pope Francis often likes to say – 'God always forgives us. He never tires of this. It's we who get tired of asking for forgiveness.'
