Our fundraising grand total so far for Father Hudson's Caritas is **£477.10!**

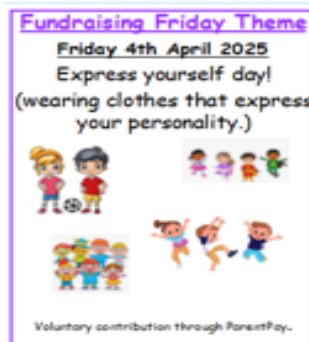
This will make a massive difference to so many people who are homeless, refugees, children and families who need support, people with disabilities and the elderly.
