Please continue to keep Jo, her husband Dave, her children and wider family in your prayers.



- A Tamworth resident working in conjunction with Farplace Animal Rescue Charity Shop has provided St. Gabriel's School with a collection bin where you can donate any unwanted school uniform, they will then be stocking the pre-loved clothing in the shop. There will also be a bin at Morrisons Tamworth and they will be accepting uniform donations at the shop inside Ankerside, Tamworth. Look out for the red bin outside the school office.
