Sunday Gospel Reflection

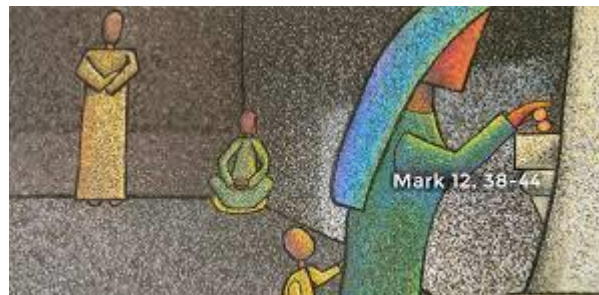
Mark 12: 38 – 44

In our Gospel this week, Jesus watches a poor widow putting two small coins into the donation box. Jesus tells His disciples that the widow has put more in than all the rich people who were putting in lots of money. It is not about how much they put in, but the spirit of generosity which they gave it with.

Jesus shows in the Gospel that we all have something we can give, even if at first it does not look like much.
