



Sunday Gospel Reflection

Third Sunday of Easter – John 21:1-19 – Feed my sheep

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus gives St Peter his special task:

Jesus asked Peter: 'Do you love me?" Peter answered, "Lord, you know all things. You know that I love you." Jesus said, "Feed my sheep."

Like Peter, Jesus has a special task for each of us. St Peter's task was to lead the Church, our task may not seem as significant, but each one is given only to us.
