

On Friday 24<sup>th</sup> January, we celebrated Year of Jubilee Launch Day in school! The children and teachers have reflected on some of their highlights from the day:

**Reception** enjoyed painting their own pictures to describe their hopes for the Jubilee Year. We have thought about ways we can help our community.

For the Jubilee Launch Day, **Year 1** enjoyed watching the BDES Launch Day Livestream We also had a lot of fun drawing our own portraits of Jesus on a scroll (to reflect the Gospel of Luke 4:16-21) and writing about some ways that we will spread hope through prayer, fundraising and social action.

In **Year 2**, we were inspired by the Gospel message, together with the Icon, to create our own pieces of art depicting Jesus spreading hope around the world.

**Year 3** had a fabulous day. We really enjoyed thinking about all the ways that we could bring hope to others during this Jubilee year. During our afternoon artwork, we were able to reflect on scripture. We loved seeing what all the different classes had produced.

In **Year 4**, we considered the reactions of the crowd to Jesus' message that He was the Messiah. We enjoyed drawing our self-portraits as members of the crowd. The reactions that we focused on were belief, disbelief, reflection and joy.

**Year 5** - We really enjoyed our Jubilee launch day! We had a lovely afternoon looking at the icon created for the Jubilee. We drew our own versions for our display which looks amazing.

Last week, **Year 6** thoroughly enjoyed participating in the Jubilee launch. It was a delightful experience, with the children especially relishing the opportunity to create artwork for our display and joining in with the live stream, where we came together to sing hymns, fostering a sense of community and shared celebration of hope.
