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NHS Pharmacy First Service

Did you know that the NHS Pharmacy First Service enables children and adults to get convenient access to healthcare advice and treatment where appropriate, for seven common conditions without the potential delay of having to wait for a GP appointment?

Accessing the service may mean that can help children feel better and back to school as quickly as possible, as well as supporting parents/carers to also get better if they are unwell with one of the conditions covered under the service.

There is no need to make an appointment; parents or carers can pop into their local pharmacy with their child and ask for help under the service.

Support for the following conditions can be accessed under the service, free of charge (unless NHS prescription charges apply):

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Track My Read - Helping children to love reading!

Well Done to all our readers who contributed to a total of 41, 655 minutes of reading during our Autumn Term 2 Track My Read challenge.

A huge congratulations to our winning class, 5LM who clocked up a super impressive 14,565 minutes and will be rewarded with their own non-uniform day (on Friday 17th January) and a new class book of their choice.

Reading for pleasure - whether reading on their own or sharing a story - is one of the best ways a child can spend their time.

Research shows that:

- Reading each day can help children improve in all their school subjects
- Reading for just 6 minutes a day can reduce stress by 68%
- Children who read for pleasure are more likely to do well at GCSEs

Choosing to read provides all sorts of benefits - it's comforting, relaxing, reduces anxiety, builds empathy and understanding and aids learning... but above all it's fun!

We have a new whole school Track My Read challenge for the Spring Term! We've set our pupils a whole school reading challenge - to read 60, 000 minutes during Spring Term, and we'd love all of the children to participate.

The class who tracks the most minutes, will be rewarded with their own non-uniform day and a class book of their choice.

Log in information for the Spring Term challenge will be sent home with your child. If you are having any problems with your log in details please let your child's class teacher know and we can rectify this for you.
