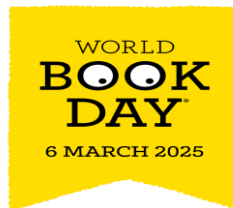

#### Sunday Gospel Reflection

#### **First Sunday of Lent – Luke 4: 1 – 13 - *Jesus was led by the Spirit in the wilderness***

On Wednesday Ash Wednesday - we marked the start of a very important season in the Church's Liturgical Calendar – Lent.

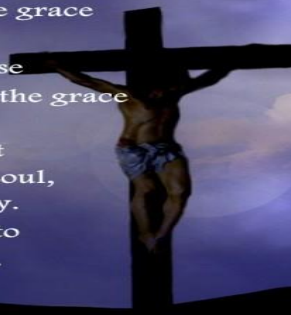
Lent is a 40-day season marking the time from Ash Wednesday to Easter Sunday. Lent is a wonderful opportunity for us as individuals, families and as a community to pray, do kind things for other people, give up things and give to others, as we prepare to celebrate the great feast of Easter.

Lent draws its inspiration from the 40 days Jesus spent in the desert. Jesus entered the desert to prepare for starting his mission proclaiming God's Kingdom to the world. During Lent, we are invited to travel with Jesus into the desert. To find a special place for us where we can feel close to God, to give ourselves time during our busy lives when we can be fully focused on what God is saying to us and calling us to do

As we enter Lent and begin our journey to Easter, let's create our own 'wildernesses' and give ourselves the time and space to grow closer to Jesus during these 40 days.

#### *A Prayer for Lenten Grace*

Loving God,  
 During the sacred season of Lent, bring me closer to you.
