Sunday Gospel Reflection

Mark 10:46-52

What do you want me to do for you?

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus heals Bartimaeus by restoring his sight.

Bartimaeus knew that Jesus could help him. He persisted in asking Jesus for help, even when other people were telling him not to.

Jesus heard Bartimaeus and said to him 'What do you want me to do for you?'

This is the same question Jesus asks us. Jesus wants us to meet him in prayer and He promises to listen and respond.

This week, bring to Jesus your answer to His question. Talk with Jesus like Bartimaeus did – throw off your cloak, jump up (Mark 10:50) and talk to Jesus about those things which are closest to your heart.
