




Please see the information below, regarding the format for the day.


- KS2 sports day will start at 9:25am and run till 11:55am. Parents can enter the school field from 9:15am onwards from the KS2 gate.
- KS1 sports day will start at 1:15pm and run until 2:55pm. Parents can enter the school field from 1:05pm onwards from the KS2 gate.
- Children in KS1 and KS2 can come to school in sporty clothes or the colour of their house: St Bernadette (orange); St Francis (blue); St Joseph (green) and St Theresa (red). Obviously, if your child does not have these colours, a sporty outfit will be fine.
- Children in Reception will come to school in their normal PE kits.
- Please ensure your child has brought into school a bottle of water and have applied sun cream before school as they will be outside for a few hours.
- Once each sports day has finished, please could you ensure that you exit the field promptly through the KS2 gate, once the children have all gone back to their classrooms.



Wroxeter Roman City

Year 4 visited Wroxeter Roman City near Shrewsbury on Wednesday 25th June . They explored a reconstructed Roman Town House, dressed as Romans, and enjoyed designing Roman mosaics. The highlight of the visit was a guided tour by a member of staff of English Heritage dressed as a Roman. We learned about the value of money in Roman times and that the Romans bathers paid for someone to guard their clothes otherwise they risked having them stolen and returning home naked!

Sunday Gospel Reflection

Feast of Saints Peter and Paul

'You are Peter and on this rock I will build my Church.'

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of Saint Peter and Saint Paul. St Peter the rock upon which Jesus built His Church and St Paul the 'Apostle to the Gentiles.'


Saint Peter and Saint Paul both had a great love for Jesus and spent their lives sharing his good news with as many people as they could. Both of them were killed because of their faith in Jesus.

Saint Peter was a fisherman when Jesus called him to be a disciple. He was a great friend of Jesus and, although he sometimes made mistakes, became an important leader of the very first Christians.

Saint Paul was originally called Saul. At first he tried to find Jesus' followers to put them into prison or even have them killed. One day he had a vision of the risen Jesus and everything changed. He travelled many thousands of miles to share the message of Jesus. He also wrote many letters that are now in the Bible.

Peter and Paul were ordinary people, who had made mistakes but who listened to and followed Jesus. They dedicated their lives to sharing his message of love and forgiveness.

We may be ordinary people too. But we can also try to follow Jesus and share his message of love.
