### **Sunday Gospel Reflection**

### Third Sunday of Lent – Luke 13:1-9

### A man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard

In our Sunday Gospel this week, Jesus tells his disciples a parable about a fig tree. The fig tree hasn't grown or produced any fruit for many years, but a kind gardener offers to help and give the tree more time to grow.

Lent is a fantastic time for us to grow in Jesus. How do you want to grow? What do you want to change? What fruit do you want to share? The gardener brought nutrients and dug round the fig tree to help it grow – prayer is our nutrient.

Spend time this week in prayer and ask Jesus to help you to grow ever closer and nearer to him.
