Solemnity of Christ the King

John 18: 33-37

Yes I am a King

This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King. This is the final Sunday before we start the new Church Year on the 1st Sunday of Advent.

The Solemnity of Christ the King remind us that Jesus is our true King. Jesus is the King of the Universe, the World and of our hearts.

We are following Jesus our King. We are part of His eternal Kingdom. It is not a kingdom of palaces and riches. Jesus is not interested in kingdoms like that. Jesus's Kingdom is one where we 'love one another as I (Jesus) have loved you.' It is a Kingdom which welcomes the vulnerable, the needy and the lonely.
