





#### **Sunday Gospel Reflection**

*Pentecost Sunday – John 14 – The Holy Spirit will teach you all things.*

Jesus's disciples must have felt a real mix of emotions when they watched him ascend up into heaven. Joy and happiness for being there as Jesus accomplished His earthly mission, but also fear and anxiety as they realised that they were now reasonable for carrying on Jesus's work here on earth.

Jesus knew this – so He told His disciples that He was sending them the Holy Spirit to be with them as their guide and support. Jesus promised this to all His disciples – we are His disciples too and the Holy Spirit is sent to journey with us as well.
