Sunday Gospel Reflection


25th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Luke 16:19-31

At his gate was laid a poor man

The Gosepl Reading this Sunday is a poweful reminder of the call for us to put our faith into action. The rich man in the parable ignored or didn't even notice the poor man who was outside his gate.

Catholic Social Teaching calls on us to live out the gospel message of showing care, respect and compassion to all those around us – especially those who are more vulnerable and needy.

As Jesus says in the Gospel of Matthew: In truth I tell you, in so far as you did this to one of the least of these brothers [or sisters] of mine, you did it to me.
