


#### 30<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time – Luke 18:9-14

#### The Parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus shares the parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector. In the parable, the Pharisee judges the tax collector. The Phairsee is certain that the tax collector was not as good as he was – he even tells God that he is better than the tax collector! – 'I fast twice a week. I give tithes (donate) of all that I get... I am not like this tax collector.'

But we are all equal and special in the eyes of God, who loves us all.

The tax collector, in fact, is much closer to God. The tax collector asks God 'Be mericful to me, a sinner.' It is the tax collector who knows he is no better than anyone else and that only God could give him the forgiveness and mercy he needs.
