

Functional Skills

English - Entry Levels, Level 1 & 2

From entry level to level 2, you can improve your reading, writing, discussion and presentation skills with a functional skills English course at Acorn Training.

We address your skills shortages rapidly from your starting point with an individual plan to meet your specific needs, developing your everyday English skills for life and work.

Maths - Entry Levels, Level 1 & 2

Your individual plan of learning builds on your strengths and what you can already do and know. You will develop skills with number, measure, shape and space and develop your ability to work with and handle data.

Digital Skills

Entry Levels, Level 1 & 2


Cybersecurity & Digital - Level 1

This course focuses on the foundational knowledge and skills needed to navigate the digital world safely and effectively. This includes understanding basic cybersecurity principles, common cybercrimes, and how to use digital devices and online services responsibly.



Business Admin - Level 1

This course has been designed to give learners the skills and knowledge to work in an entry position in a business admin role. Learning will be delivered in modules and will focus on business tools, documents and job opportunities.



Personal Development for Employability - Entry 3 & Level 1

Prepare yourself for a range of different employment opportunities with this PDE course. The teaching guides learners through the job searching process, CV writing and interview techniques to achieve both short and long-term career goals.



Mental Health Awareness & First Aid & Advocacy - Level 2

The course raises awareness and understanding of mental health conditions and the principles of mental health first aid.

Nutrition, Health & Wellbeing - Level 1

Explore the value of nutrition, health & wellbeing in both life and work. Learners will develop knowledge of their own and others' wellbeing and the importance of good practices.

Understanding SEND - Level 2



BOOSTING WELLBEING TO UNLOCK JOB OPPORTUNITIES

After completing the Beginners IT course, Jonathan was eager to keep building his digital confidence. He progressed onto the IT Office Skills course, where he gained practical experience with advanced features of Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint. He now uses these tools with greater independence and confidence, ready to take on new opportunities. He now feels more hopeful applying for jobs that require digital skills, expanding his career options and evidencing his expertise.

Jonathan said: "I've really benefitted from the course and learnt so much more about using Office apps. The support has been great, and I feel a lot more positive about my next steps".
