


Track My Read

Sunday Gospel Reflection

First Sunday of Advent – Matthew 24:37-44 - Stay Awake!

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus encourages His disciples to 'stay awake!'

Jesus wants us to stay awake so that we are ready for His Coming. Jesus also wants us to 'stay awake' to the needs of the world around us. Awake to those who are sad, lonely, hungry or suffering at this time of year. Awake to the Holy Spirit who will send us opportunities every day to help those who need us. **And then we will be truly 'awake' to Jesus.**



Pray As You Go

Pray As You Go is a prayer app, designed to go with you wherever you go, to help you pray whenever you find time, but particularly whilst travelling to and from work, study, etc. The sessions consist of music, Bible readings, reflection and time for prayer.

During Advent, Pray As You Go are sharing an online Advent Retreat called Advent Psalms – 'a gentle rhythm of audio reflections designed to help you enter more deeply into this season of waiting and hope.' Each week of Advent, a 20-minute session will be released (via the Pray As You Go app) inviting you to look forward to the birth of Jesus as the source of all hope for our world.
