Sunday Gospel Reflection

Second Sunday in Ordinary Time – John 1:29-34


‘Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world’

In this Sunday’s Gospel, John the Baptist bears witness to Jesus.

John the Baptist tells his followers that he has ‘seen and borne witness that (Jesus) is the Son of God.’

Like John the Baptist, we too are called to be witnesses to Jesus. John the Baptist was called to prepare the way for Jesus by calling people to repentance at the news of the arrival of the Kingdom of God.

We may feel that we have not been given such an ‘important’ role, but each of us is called to witness to Jesus in our daily lives – through our words, deeds and actions. Like John the Baptist we are called to make our very lives a witness to ‘the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world.’
