Thank you to all these parents who have continued to inform and communicate with us via this e-mail.

KEY INFECTION AND PREVENTION CONTROLS REMAIN IN PLACE as published in the "daily plan". By following these measures we all reduce risks in our setting and create a safer environment. We <u>MUST</u> always:

- 1. Minimise contact with individuals who are unwell by ensuring that those who have coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms, or who have someone in their household who does, do not attend school.
- 2. Ensure face coverings are used in recommended circumstances.
- 3. Ensure everyone is advised to clean their hands thoroughly and more often than usual.
- 4. Ensure good respiratory hygiene for everyone by promoting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach
- 5. Maintain enhanced cleaning, including cleaning frequently touched surfaces often using standard products, such as detergents.
- 6. Consider how to minimise contact across the site and maintain social distancing wherever possible.
- 7. Keep occupied spaces well ventilated.
- 8. Ensure individuals wear the appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) where necessary.
- 9. Promote and engage in asymptomatic testing, where available.
- 10. Promote and engage with the NHS Test and Trace process.
- 11. Manage and report confirmed cases of coronavirus (COVID-19) amongst the school community.
- 12. Contain any outbreak by following local health protection team advice.

#### Sports Days

The children will be having some additional year group sports in the days ahead, co ordinated by teachers and Mr Fowler.

However, given the surging suspected and confirmed case rates in Tamworth area, we have been advised <u>NOT</u> to have the assembly of large groups of parents and relatives on the site. Please accept this for what it is, a decision made in the context of ever changing advice and circumstances. It is as frustrating for us as it must be for you. Throughout this time all we have focussed on is trying to make the school safe, in line with the guidance we are asked to follow.

## Sickness Bugs

Parents and Carers of all children are reminded that where a child has been ill where vomiting has been involved, you are advised to keep your child at home until they have been 24 hours clear. If there is any diarrhoea then they have to be 48 hours clear. This is to prevent the spread of symptoms to other children. Thank you.

#### DEFERRED INSET DAY

The school cancelled the Inset day which was to be taken on 29<sup>th</sup> January 2021 in order to stay open for key worker and vulnerable children. In line with government guidance, I have consulted with the chair of governors and have identified when this day will now be taken. This teacher training day will now be taken on <u>Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2021</u>. The final day for pupils will therefore be Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

# Collection at end of day

All parents and carers are reminded - wait patiently as children are dismissed. We can only send one child at a time, while the teacher records the adult collecting. Please be clear that this is to satisfy safeguarding requirements and to ensure <u>ALL</u> children go home safely. Parents are asked NOT TO QUEUE OFF MARLBOROUGH ROAD OR WILNECOTE LANE as this is blocking the flow of local traffic. Thank you.

#### Bikes

If using the cycle rack to leave bikes or scooters on the school premises then please ensure they are secured with a bike lock. We cannot accept any responsibility for any bikes or scooters left on school premises. Thank you

#### Hot Weather

Now that the weather is warmer please remember to send your child in with a suitable hat to wear at playtimes. Please ensure that on hot/sunny days you apply cream BEFORE YOUR CHILD COMES TO SCHOOL. Do not send children to school with bottles of sun cream. We are not allowed to apply sun cream for children.

Children need to have had their hay fever medication before they come in to school and bring a water bottle with them. Unless there is a medical reason, children should not be bringing sunglasses into school. Please ensure all belongings are named and labelled. Thank you

Staffordshire County Council are writing to all parents/carers of eligible children (via school) with a unique code to register their interest and receive a timetable of activities.


