### End of Key Stage 2 Assessments

#### % of pupils reaching the expected standard and working at a "high level"

Meeting the expected standard in Reading and Maths means that a pupil scored 100 or above on the standardised SATs test.

In writing it means that a pupil has demonstrated to their teacher that they meet all the criteria linked to the required standard.

Working at a high level in Reading and Maths means that a pupil reached 110 or above on the standardised SATs test.

In writing, it means that a pupil has demonstrated to their teacher that they are working at a greater depth within the Year 6 writing criteria.
