Based on the gospel for Sunday 15 May, Fifth Sunday of Easter: John 13:31-35

"Love one another just as I have loved you."

In John's Gospel account of the Last Supper, Jesus gives us a new commandment: we are to "love one another" in the same way that Jesus loved us. It will be by the way that we show love that we will be recognised as his disciples.

One of the ways in which we can answer this call is through acts of charity, such as by making a donation. However, we should be mindful of what St Paul says in 1 Corinthians 13: "though I should give away to the poor all that I possess.... if I am without love, it will do me no good whatever."

There is more to love than just giving money. We need to enter into relationship, stand in solidarity with and empathise with the situation of our sisters and brothers throughout the world if we are to truly love them.

By finding out more about the lives, hopes and dreams of people, by listening to their voices and learning what it is like to be in their shoes, and by praying for them, we can start to build that relationship of love and fulfil Jesus' commandment.
