Based on the gospel for 20 June, Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time: Mark 4:35-41

“Then it began to blow a great gale and the waves were breaking into the boat so that it was almost swamped.”

Have you ever felt unsettled by the power of a storm? It is a power that is beyond our control. There are many people who in this last year may have experienced a similar feeling about COVID. I know I did at times, because events during the pandemic have also been beyond our control.

Maybe some of us have felt that the boats of our lives have been swamped by the waves. Or that Jesus is asleep in the stern. Seemingly, inattentive to our needs. Yet, this reading reminds us to have faith, all is not lost, for he is with us.

Holding onto this hope, let us remember and help to show to others, that Jesus’ eyes are fixed on each of us and especially those of us who feel overwhelmed. Let us remember that his hands are there to lift us up. How his feet are walking gently in our wake.
